22 March 2018 - Maastricht

The Centre for European Research in Maastricht (CERiM) is an interdisciplinary research venue creating synergies and stimulating joint projects and events in the fields of European law, governance, and their respective history. It brings together more than one hundred researchers from the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences and the Faculty of Law of Maastricht University and from University College Maastricht. Under the umbrella of the overall theme Reshaping Europe in a Globalising World, CERiM's research agenda focuses on four main research themes: Differentiation and Flexible Integration, Constitutionalising Europe, European Governance and Market Integration, and Europe and the World.

CERiM organizes a one-day PhD workshop on 22 March 2018 to offer PhD candidates an opportunity to present papers related to CERiM's research agenda. Leading researchers including CERiM Directors Prof. Thomas Christiansen and Prof. Ellen Vos will comment on these papers, and after the workshop, the revised papers are expected to be published as Working Papers in CERiM's online paper series.

We welcome paper proposals on **The future of European governance** by PhD candidates pursuing research in law, political science and history. Abstracts (250 words maximum) should be sent, together with a short CV, to cerim@maastrichtuniversity.nl **before 8 January 2018**. Decisions on the abstracts can be expected by the end of January 2018. Selected paper givers will be required to send a draft paper **by the 8 March 2018**. Limited funding is available to support travel and accommodation expenses.
