Art. 12 Breaches of privacy

- ¹ Anyone who processes personal data must not unlawfully breach the privacy of the data subjects in doing so.
- ² In particular, he must not:
- process personal data in contravention of the principles of
 Articles 4, 5 paragraph 1 and 7 paragraph 1;
- process data pertaining to a person against that person's express wish without justification;
- c.
 disclose sensitive personal data or personality profiles to third parties without justification.¹
- ³ Normally there is no breach of privacy if the data subject has made the data generally accessible and has not expressly prohibited its processing.
