## Art. 15<sup>1</sup>Legal claims

- <sup>1</sup> Actions relating to protection of privacy are governed by Articles 28, 28a and 28l of the Civil Code<sup>2</sup>. The plaintiff may in particular request that data processing be stopped, that no data be disclosed to third parties, or that the personal data be corrected or destroyed.
- <sup>2</sup> Where it is impossible to demonstrate that personal data is accurate or inaccurate, the plaintiff may request that a note to this effect be added to the data.
- <sup>3</sup> The plaintiff may request that notification of third parties or the publication of the correction, destruction, blocking, and in particular the prohibition of disclosure to third parties, the marking of the data as disputed or the court judgment.
- <sup>4</sup> Actions on the enforcement of a right to information shall be decided by the courts in a simplified procedure under the Civil Procedure Code of 19 December 2008<sup>3</sup>.
