## Art. 17 Legal basis

- <sup>1</sup> Federal bodies may process personal data if there is a statutory basis for doing so.
- <sup>2</sup> They may process sensitive personal data and personality profiles only if a formal enactment expressly provides therefor or if, by way of exception:
- such processing is essential for a task clearly defined in a formal enactment;
- b.
  the Federal Council authorises processing in an individual case because the rights of the data subject are not endangered; or
- the data subject has given his consent in an individual case or made his data general accessible and has not expressly prohibited its processing.<sup>1</sup>
